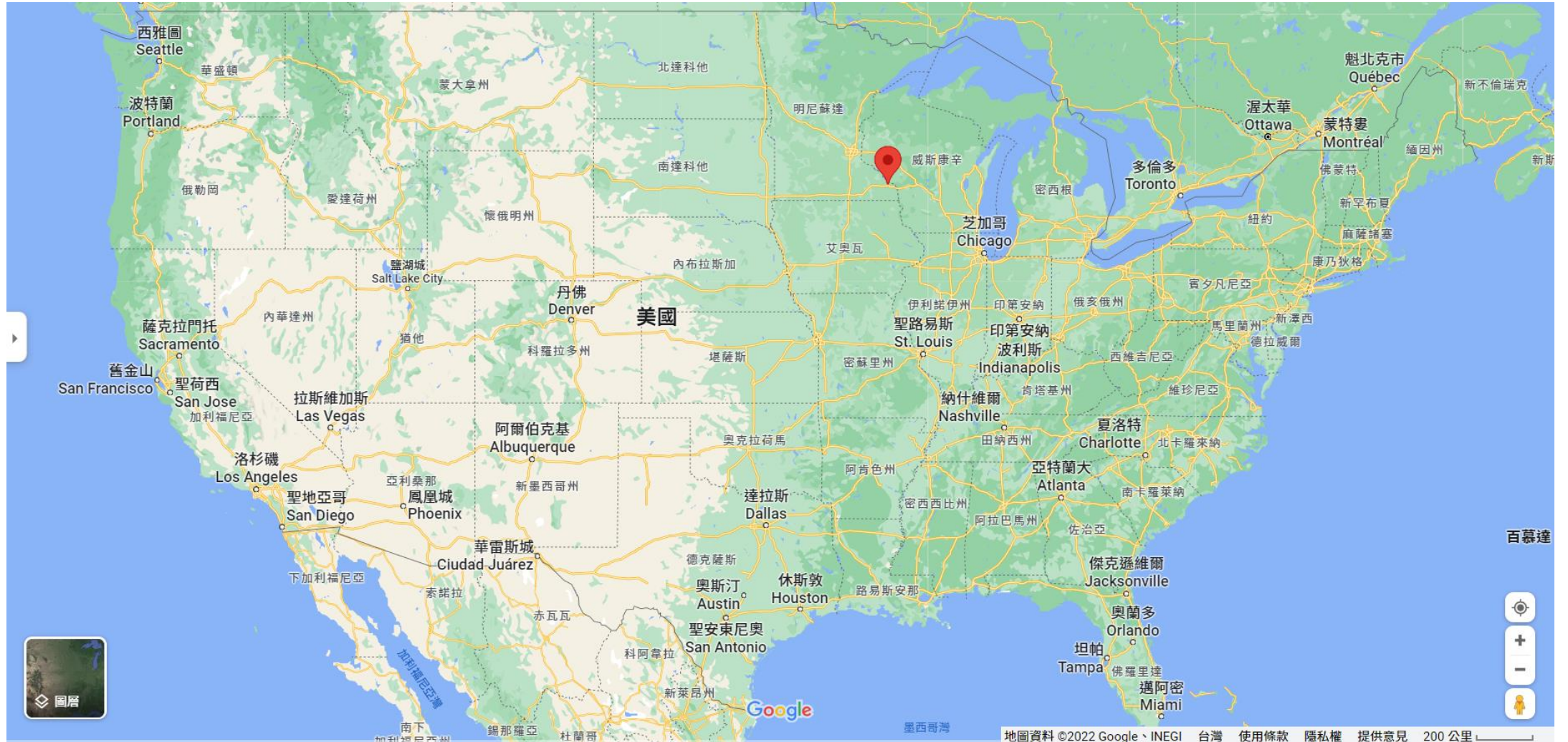

About WSU

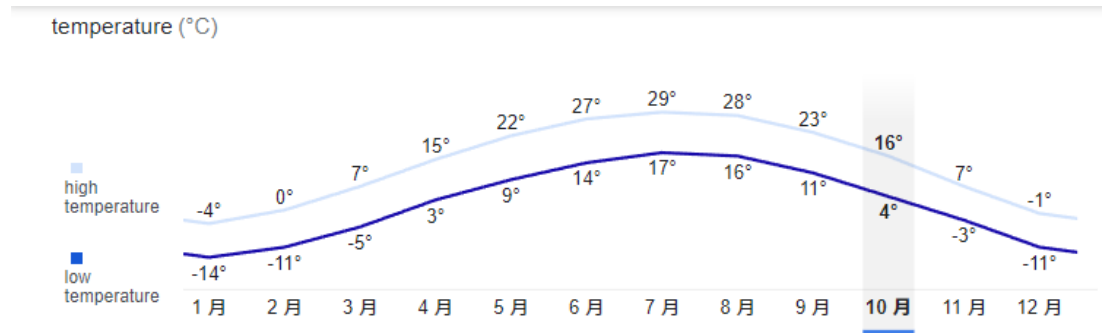
- Winona State University (WSU) is a public university in Winona, Minnesota, United States.

- Its average annual enrollment is approximately 9,000 undergraduate and graduate students.



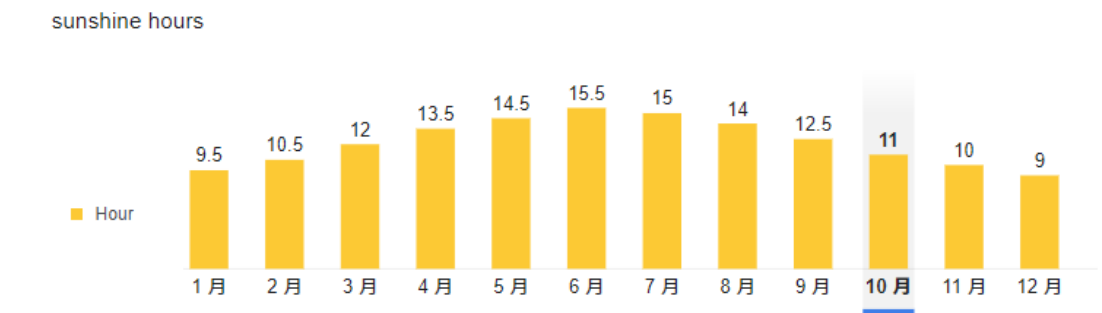
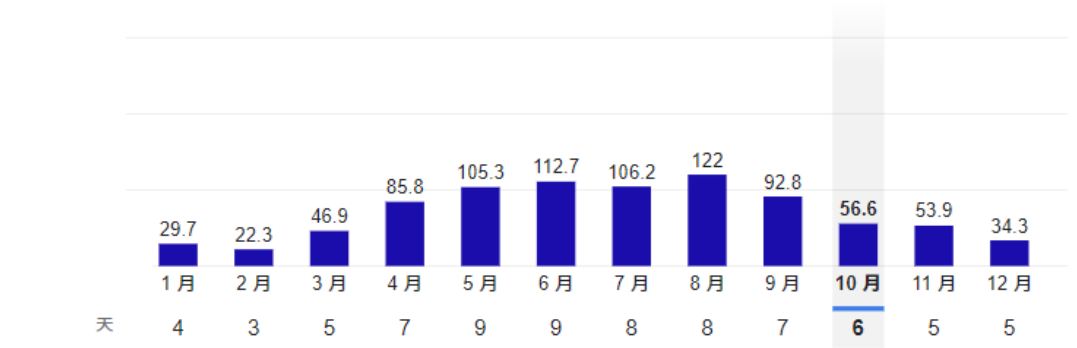

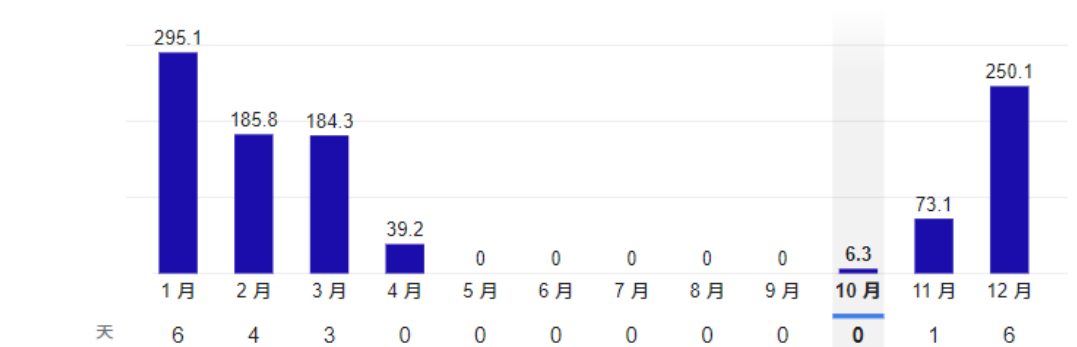
Climate and Average Weather Year Round in Winona

Computer science majors choose between two options: Computer Science (CS) and Applied Computer Science (ACS). Both options require a common core set of courses designed to give students a fundamental understanding of both theoretical and applied computer science, and an introduction to current topics and practices in the industry. Upper-level courses within each option build on these concepts to provide depth in particular areas. As such, all computer science majors are prepared for computer science careers and, if they desire, further graduate study in computer-related fields.

Cross-Cultural Scholarship (CCS)

- All international students receive the Cross-Cultural Scholarship.
- The Cross-Cultural Scholarship covers the difference between the tuition rate for residents and the rate for non-residents. This means that you'll pay the same amount in tuition as a student from Minnesota.
- You will automatically receive the scholarship when you enroll as an international student at Winona State University.
- To maintain the scholarship, you must meet the following requirements:

Cross-Cultural Scholarship (CCS)

- To maintain the scholarship, you must meet the following requirements:
 1. Maintain a valid F-1 or J-1 Immigration Status.
 2. Complete the required number Cross-Cultural Outreach projects.
Projects are categorized as Major, or Minor based on the time needed to complete each. One Major and one Minor project are required each fall and spring semester enrolled as a full-time student.
 3. Maintain a cumulative GPA of 2.50.
