#### <u>Undergraduate (bachelor's) students</u>

- Must have completed at least 2 semesters of **full-time** study at home university before studying at Temple
- GPA:
  - Exchange Applicants: 3.00/4.00
  - Study Abroad/Fee-Paying Applicants: 2.75/4.00
- English requirements: TOEFL (79 iBT, 550 ITP), IELTS (6.0), Duolingo English Test (110), CEFR (B2), or TOEIC Listening & Reading Test (390 in each section)\*
